

OPERA HOUSE



An explosion of color to liven the gray days of winter!
This vest is a symphony of crochet stitches, which perfectly work with the colorful threads of Opera House for a unique result.

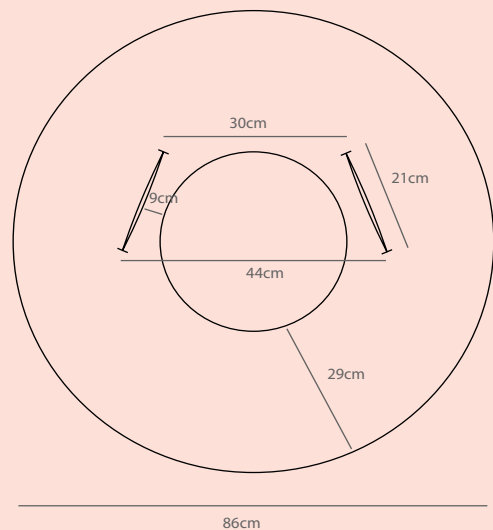


Yarn: ECHOS PRINT col. 4360.

Crochet Hook: n. 10

Weight: 470 g/ 16,58 oz. (10 balls)

Stitches used: Radial Circle, Treble, Reverse Single Crochet.



Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 inc. x 4 inc.): 17 stitches and 11 rounds.

One Size: Vest has a diameter of 86 cm (33,86 in.).

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EXECUTION

Using crochet hook n. 10 and col. 4360, cast on 4 chains and join in round, then work according to the scheme of **Radial Circle**.

Once completed the scheme, work 3 rounds in **Treble** with the same number of stitches.

Then, for the armhole, work as follows: 24 stitches in **Treble**, leave out the working on 16 stitches and instead make 20 chains, 50 stitches in **Treble**, leave out the working on 16 stitches and instead make 20 chains.

Continue working in **Treble**, making:

- 1 round with 1 increase every 12 stitches
- 1 round without increases
- 1 round with 1 increase every 10 stitches
- 1 round without increases
- 1 round with 1 increase every 6 stitches
- 2 rounds without increases
- 1 round with 1 increase every 4 stitches

- 2 rounds without increases

Then make a round in **Reverse Single Crochet** and fasten the thread.

To finish the armhole, we made a round in **Reverse Single Crochet**.
