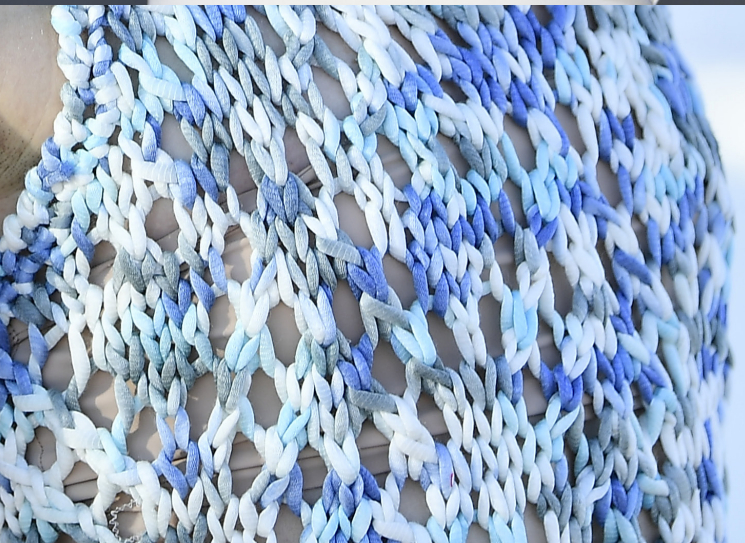

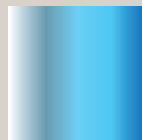
GRAPE TOP

45% COTTON



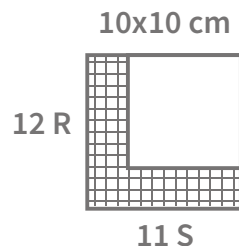

DIFFICULTY: ADVANCED

SIZE: 10/12

GAUGE AND FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Worked in an openwork diamond
pattern with 12 mm needles



MEASUREMENTS:

Size 10 shown in the photo
Width: 42 cm
Total length: 48 cm
Length from armhole to
hem: 30 cm
Armhole depth: 18 cm

MATERIALS

PESCA PRINT by SESIA 2 gomitoli da 100 g. col. 4828

NEEDLES: n. 12

CROCHET HOOK: n. 8

OTHER: Tape needle (bodkin), stitch markers, scissors, pins, measuring tape

STITCHES

WITH NEEDLES:

Garner stitch: Work all rows knit.

Openwork diamond stitch: Worked on a multiple of 10 stitches + 1, following the chart and repeating Rows 1–24 until the required length is reached.

WITH CROCHET:

Chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet, crab stitch (worked like single crochet, proceeding from left to right).

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: the garment is made of two panels, front and back, worked separately and joined together at the end.

In each row of the section up to the armholes of both panels, keep the first and last 2 edge stitches: work the first 2 stitches knit, and slip the last 2 stitches without working them, keeping the yarn in front.

BACK:

Cast on 45 stitches and for the lower border work 3 rows in garter stitch, keeping the first 2 and last 2 stitches as edge stitches.

Then set the work as follows: 2 edge stitches, 41 stitches in openwork diamond pattern (working the first 5 stitches of the chart, repeating the 10-stitch pattern repeat 3 times, and working the last 6 stitches of the chart), 2 edge stitches.

Continue as set until completing the 36th row of the openwork diamond pattern, then begin shaping the armholes, binding off 5 stitches on both sides, then always at the sides and every 2 rows bind off first 2 stitches and then 1 stitch.

From the armholes onward, proceed without the edge stitches.

Continue in the diamond pattern over the remaining 29 stitches and, at 18 cm from the beginning of the armholes (or 48 cm total height), bind off all stitches.

FRONT:

Work as for the back until reaching 40 cm total height.

Then begin shaping the neckline by binding off the central 13 stitches.

Continue working the two sides separately, binding off 2 stitches on each side of the neckline. Proceed on the remaining 6 stitches. After 18 cm from the beginning of the armholes (or 48 cm total height), bind off the stitches of each shoulder.

ASSEMBLY AND FINISHING:

Place the two panels together (RS facing RS) and sew the shoulder seams.

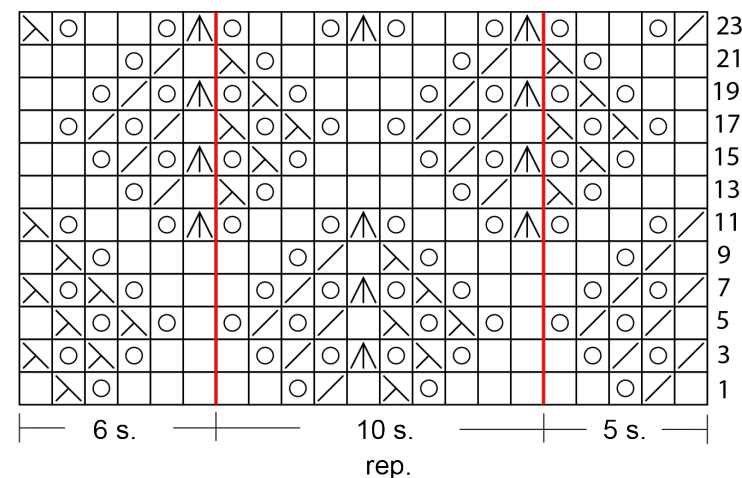
Then, starting from the bottom of the tank top and leaving the first 20 cm of the side edges open, sew the side seams up to the armholes.

Neckline edging: Using the crochet hook, work one round of single crochet evenly around the neckline, then finish with one round of crab stitch.

Armhole edging: Finish the armholes in the same way as the neckline. Fasten off all yarn ends.

Odd rows (RS) are read from right to left.

Even rows (WS), not shown in the chart, are worked purl.

Always repeat Rows 1–24 until reaching the point indicated.
