## **AUDRY**



This knitted top combines a shaved knit in the upper part with a lively openwork pattern in the lower part, creating a light and airy effect.



**Gauge:** 10 x 10 cm = 11 sts and 14 rows in stockinette stitch with 10 mm needles, measured after blocking

### **NOTE**

The tank top is worked in one piece (front and back) from the bottom up to the armholes.

Yarn: PESCA col 157

Circular Needels: needle tips size 8 mm

and 10 mm, 80 cm cable

**Weight:** 150 g (2 balls)

Size: S

Stiched Used: Garter stitch in the round, Lace

ribbing in the round, Stockinette stitch flat

#### STITCH PATTERNS

Garter stitch in the round

Lace ribbing in the round (follow instructions in the front/back sections)

Stockinette stitch flat

Row 1 and all odd rows (RS): knit all stitches.

Row 2 and all even rows (WS): purl all stitches. Stockinette stitch in the round: knit all stitches on every round. To facilitate the work, place a stitch marker (SM) at the end of each round and move it up as you progress.

Grafting (Kitchener stitch) for seaming

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

SM = stitch marker (beginning of round)

SSM = slip stitch marker

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

k2tog = knit two together

ssk = slip, slip, knit

dbl-dec (centered double decrease) = slip 2 sts together as if to knit, knit the next st, pass the 2 slipped sts over the knit st

CO = cast on

BO = bind off (cast off)

rep = repeat

### INSTRUCTIONS FRONT AND BACK UNTIL ARMHOLES

With 8 mm needle tips and 80 cm cable, CO 92 sts, join in the round and place a SM.

Bottom Border (Garter Stitch in the Round)

1st round: purl all stitches.

2nd round: knit all stitches.

3rd round: purl all stitches.

Switch to 10 mm needle tips and continue in lace ribbing as follows:

1st round: (yo, dbl-dec, yo, k1 tbl) repeat to end of round.

2nd round: (k3, k1 tbl) repeat to end of round.

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 until 20 rounds are completed.

From round 21 to 25: continue in stockinette stitch in the round.

Round 26: Knit to 4 sts before SM, p4, SSM.

Round 27: p4, k38, p8, k38.

Rounds 28-29: Repeat rounds 26 and 27.

Round 30: Repeat round 26.

Round 31: k2, BO 4 sts, k2, k38, k2, BO 4 sts, k2, k38, slip next 2 sts to the right needle, cut the yarn,

and turn the work.

Now work back and forth on the first 42 sts, leaving the remaining 42 sts on hold.

### **UPPER BACK**

Row 0 (WS): p2, p38, p2.

Row 1 (RS): p1, p2tog, knit to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.

Row 2 (WS): purl all stitches.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until row 8 is completed. Row 9: p1, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.

Row 10: purl all stitches. Row 11: Repeat row 9.

Row 12: p4, BO 22 sts, p4.

Continue working on these 4 sts for 40 rows to create

the first strap. Place these 4 sts on hold.

### **UPPER FRONT**

Work the 42 held stitches as for the upper back, including the strap.

#### **FINISHING**

Graft the held front and back stitches and the corresponding strap stitches using Kitchener stitch. Weave in all ends, soak and block the garment to measurements.
